

## 1- Development / Construction Projects

#### 1. 1- Berth No. 27 at Basrah Gateway Terminal (BGT)

Basrah Mas was selected as the sole main contractor to International Container Terminal Services Inc. (ICTSI) to construct three berths at their Basrah Gateway Terminal (BGT) in Umm Qasr Port.

Phase 1 of the project consisted of:

- 1. Quay structure of 208 m X 30 m
- 2. Powerhouse
- 3. Electrical substation
- 4. 11 Kv transmission line
- 5. Access road from Umm Qasr south port
- 6. Administration building
- 7. Water treatment plant
- 8. 150,000 m² interlock paved area for storage
- 9. Road network and fencing
- 10. Firehouse
- 11. Workshops
- 12. Cathodic protection system

#### 1. 2- Berths No. 25 and 26 at Basrah Gateway Terminal (BGT)

For phase 2 of the Three Berths contract with International Container Terminal Services Inc. (ICTSI)/Basrah Gateway Terminal (BGT) in Umm Qasr Port, Basrah Mas proceeded with the construction of Berths No. 25 and 26 with a quay structure of 300 m X 42 m and more than 250,000  $\rm m^2$  of stacking yards.

#### 1. 3- The development and construction of Berths No. 11 and

#### 11A at Umm Qasr Port

The work constituted constructing the quay structure and all ancillaries, as well as construction more than 100,000 m<sup>2</sup> of stacking yards, utilizing interlock paving stone as bearing floor for the first time in Umm Qasr Port.

# 1.6 - Construction work inBerths No. 2 and 3 at UmmQasr Port

This involved the construction of 10 tanks for storing raw edible oil of 4,000 tons each, as well as ship unloader and truck loading station with all piping and pumps, complete rehabilitation of the structure of Berth No. 2 and complete rehabilitation of Berth No. 3, which is meant for all sugar importations.

# 1. 7- The developing of Berths No. 19, 20, and 21 at Umm Qasr Port

This involved the construction of the stacking yard, cathodic protection revamping for the berths, fences and guardrails, and all electrical systems, or, in other words, a complete rehabilitation of the berths' infrastructures.

# 8- Main gas pipeline feeder for Umm Qasr power plant (UQPP)

Basrah Mas was contracted by PMPH on behalf of GCPI to design and construct a 10" main gas pipeline feeder of 15 km length to feed the Umm Qasr gasfired power plant.

Feeding capacity 25 mmscf/day along with all inplant feeding connections. All field inspections were carried out by Oil Pipeline Company (government company). A major crossing of 150 meters length of this project was conducted by horizontal directional drilling (HDD) technique.

#### 9- Infrastructure, landscape, and concrete works for Umm Qasr Power Plant (UQPP)

This included a powerhouse and engine room, control building, filter structure, main gas feeding line within the premises of the plant, all roads and walkways, as well as lighting and landscaping.

# 1. 10- Dredging work in front of Berth No. 27

A total of 800,000 cubic meters of materials were dredged in front of Berth No. 27 to reach navigational depths per the requirement of Umm Qasr Port. IHC suction cutter dredgers were used with a maximum dredging depth of 16 meters and an in/out suction pipe of 600 mm.

The General Company for Ports of Iraq (GCPI) needed a control tower in Umm Qasr Port. The concrete tower is 45 m tall and has an observation chamber on top that is equipped with a communication system, a telescope system, and a radar unit.


The project also included all of the required services and structures, along with an office area and lodging quarters for the officials.

#### 1. 12- Inland Container Dry Port (ICD) at Umm Qasr Port

This is an area for container handling and storage with a total area of 100,000 m², multi-functional covered storage facilities and ancillary buildings. One of our innovations in this project was to use precast interlock concrete tiles to pave the storage areas, especially the container-stacking yard. This innovation was accepted and approved by the General Company for Ports of Iraq and by the client after a thorough analysis that was performed in conjunction with the University of Basrah.

#### 1.14- Al-Magel Pedestrian Bridge

The design and construction of the bridge were completely handled by the company. The main engineering challenge was floating and hauling the bridge in position.

with a dedicated telecommunication system with an integrated security system.

The building was the vision of the founder of the company, the late Eng. Ali K. Khalaf, merging prefab steel structure and steel prefabricated cement board partitions to structure the building and an elaborate space for future extension. Now it houses all Basrah Mas operations.

#### 2. 1- Horizon Hotel


G+8 store building, four-star hotel, total plot area of 600 m². The hotel houses 81 rooms and suites in addition to a meeting room, gym, spa, and the main restaurant (Acacia). State-of-the-art finishing was used in decorating all of the interior finishing. The furniture was tailor-made to meet the design requirement. All exterior cladding was imported from abroad and tailored to meet the design sets.

#### 2. 2- Basrah Bowling Center

It accommodates six lanes, as well as recreational facilities. It is a unique structure that merges steel with brick and concrete. The building's recreational area accommodates more than 300 people, is well equipped with a kitchen, and rests completely offshore on mini bundles of piles. The project is an icon in Basrah city.

#### 2. 3- Basrah Family Park

The park is plotted on an area of 17,000 m², equipped with up-to-date amusement ride machines. Making use of the nearby waterway, the park has many water-sport activities, such as jet skiing and speed boat tours. Before reclamation, the area was a dump area which, at times, hosted many insurgents' activities.

#### 2. 4- Residential apartments

#### 2.5- Mas Cinema

The design of the project is considered state of the art. The whole structure is on an offshore platform resting on piles. A unique cladding element was used in the exterior cladding, making it the only building in the country to use COR-TEN steel cladding material. The two cinema halls house 160 people, and the café/restaurant can accommodate up to 300 people.

#### 2. 6- Mas for events

A two-story steel structure building ready to accommodate festivals and events such as weddings and meetings. It is located next to the Basrah Family Park on the main road. The building is finished in high-quality stones and glass. The furniture was tailor-made to fit the design requirements of an event hall.

#### 3. 1- Basrah plastic factory

Basrah Mas Company was awarded an operation/ maintenance contract by one of the largest plastic factories in Basrah. The contract included production, maintenance, and marketing. The objective of the contract is to increase revenues and minimize production costs. The products include all types of plastic pipes (high-density, low-density), agricultural plastic covers, and many other products.

#### 3. 2- Horizon Hotel

Horizon Hotel is one of the bejewelled elements of our private investment. The hotel management awarded an in-house maintenance contract to Basrah Mas. The scope of the contract includes all types of maintenance of all hotel systems and the appliances to maintain operational conditions.

#### 4. 1- The Basrah Martyrs Monument

Basrah Mas contributed this monument to the city of Basrah in memory of those who had been killed in the past regime, and it reflects its contribution to the society of Basrah.

#### 4. 2- Construction of the Marine Affairs Building

Basrah Mas contributed to the evolution of the port sector by increasing the port's capacities through the introduction of new projects and by assisting in developing the administrative infrastructure of the port management. One of these contributions is the building of the Marine Affairs Department. The three-story steel structure is next to Shatt Al Arab. Exterior metal cladding and a pyramidal architectural form gave the building's exterior elegance.

#### 4. 3- Basrah Central Library revamping

Basrah Central Library is one of the oldest common free service entities of Basrah, and suffered from a long decade of ignorance and a lack of maintenance. Basrah Mas decided to carry on a complete revamping of this entity on its own account by introducing a new building while maintaining parts of the old one and introducing a new electronic system.

#### 4. 4- Waiting hall in Basrah International Airport

Elegant seating, well-furnished flooring, and glass partitions accommodated the contribution.




